Tip of the Month

To assure that your request has been received by a MUOS Spectrum Manager, contact your local Component Spectrum Manager to submit your request via Spectrum XXI.

A New Spectrum Forward

As you're aware, a Spectrum Request Form needs to be submitted prior to conducting MUOS operations. This form has been provided to you in the past to facilitate where the MUOS waveform is being operated and to help coordinate between commercial and DoD entities within Spectrum XXI.

Now, and in the future, some additional steps are needed by the requesting unit. The unit coordinates with the Component Spectrum Managers to create a SFAF (Standard Frequency Action Format) request via Spectrum XXI. This request routes to Component Spectrum Managers and Area Frequency Coordinators associated with the location the operation/test takes place. The request will be submitted to component MAJCOM through appropriate channels via Spectrum XXI. The MAJCOM submits the request to Space and Missile Defense Command (SMDC) Army Forces Strategic Command (ARSTRAT) inbox on Spectrum XXI for assignment. Once the request is sent to Julio Pueblo, the MUOS Spectrum Manager, he will spot check a few items and sub-assign off the US&P permanent assignments.





This process provides the unit's chain the appropriate visibility and allows for easier tracking for request/renewals and deletions. Additionally, the unit spectrum office can use the permanent assignments in Spectrum XXI to create a temporary requests as well to help the process for future requests.

So, what's the bottom line? Reach out to your local Spectrum Manager when you need to renew your spectrum assignment when conducting MUOS waveform operations in your Area of Operations.
